FY22 Focus & Activities

- Enhance the global competitiveness of the region to attract new investment expanding core microelectronics competencies and emerging end-market clusters.
- Expand the region's legacy microelectronics ecosystem and emerging end-market clusters.
- Expand GPEC's full-service concierge activities.
- Promote the Global Partnership Program to connect parties interested in joint venture, acquisition or investment opportunities.
- Enhance collaboration within and outside Greater Phoenix to capitalize on the region's connection to key trade partners.
- Increase private and public alignment to create or expand one applied research and commercialization centers.

Measures & Milestones

- ✓ Facilitate at least 50 collaborations between local firms, universities and international startups/scale-ups, of which 50% in the target cluster.
- ✓ Support and advocate for the modernization of federal, state and local tax and regulatory policies that open new opportunities and markets, lower the cost of production and encourage reshoring.
- ✓ Support 3-5 pitch efforts to expand the number of direct international flight destinations.
- ✓ Attract 10 investments opportunities across the value chain, from design, to front-end, back-end, testing and assembly, equipment and material suppliers, and related services.
- ✓ Target 5 international OEMs and market leaders across high-growth end-market clusters.
- ✓ Identify 10 reshoring opportunities within OEM supply chains.
- ✓ Enroll 10 user in the Grow the Global Growth Accelerator program.
- ✓ Promote the region's capabilities in workforce, infrastructure, competitive business climate, growth incubation and affordable lifestyle through 16 workshops and targeted media campaigns.
- ✓ Collaborate with partners such as SelectUSA and U.S. of Department Commerce to increase the profile of Greater Phoenix.
